I just want to restate to our members as well as non-members what the White Lake Citizens League's (WLCL) mission is, *WLCL... neighbors working with neighbors volunteering to improve communications and enhance the quality and beauty of our lake.*

The purpose of the White Lake Citizens League is to provide property owners located in the White Lake and Highland Townships an organization to manage lake-related matters of interest to all. These include but are not limited to liaison with governmental entities (Lake Improvement Board), management of WLCL projects and programs, and facilitation of communications with members. All WLCL activities are oriented toward maintaining or improving the quality and beauty of our lake. Water quality, beautification, social activities and safety are among the interests of the WLCL.

With that being said White Lake has approximately 1400 lake and lake access owners. Currently we have less than 18% contributing to the WLCL membership and volunteer committees. That is a low number of participants. In order to provide the services of weed control, keyhole access, fireworks, etc., we need more lake owners to participate.

So please become involved. It is very easy to criticize what we may or may not be doing, but we only have a handful of people working on your behalf, answering the hot line for weed and keyhole issues, securing funds for the White Lake Fireworks, and communicating to you. If we are unable to secure the financial, as well as the volunteer commitments for 2007, our league's existence will be in jeopardy.



Block Captains Needed!

We'll soon be starting the WLCL membership drive for 2007 and we'd like to begin by thanking the folks who helped out in 2006! We need more volunteers from the membership to cover open territories and help us personally contact everyone on the lake.

As many of you know, we have divided the area into 40 "Block" territories, so that each volunteer doesn't have to make too many individual contacts. We have special needs on the east side of the lake, particularly on and around Ridge Road.

The work is not complicated, and by starting early, you can pace your contacts so that the assignment won't be a great burden in your busy schedule. Here's what the job entails:

1. Contacting each resident at the waterfront addresses on your block list. Most blocks contain between 10 and 20 homes to be contacted.
2. The purpose of the contacts is as

follows:

- a. Solicit them for membership and a fireworks donation.
- b. Update our roster for ownership name changes and collect e-mail addresses (and changes of e-mail address) for all of your neighbors, whether or not they choose to join WLCL.
- c. Find people who would like to help by volunteering on WLCL's committees and/or to fill vacancies on the Block Captain squad.

We want to kick off the drive in early spring, and will be having a Block Captain's Meeting in April to get Captains briefed and equipped with forms and materials to make the contacts easy. Accordingly, we need to fill our open territories as soon as possible.

There is a new weed in town. Last year we saw "stonewart" popping up in our lake, joining the pesky, never-ending Eurasian Milfoil. Frank Dyson, our volunteer resident weed expert worked directly with Aqua-Weed Control in developing a plan of attack for 2007.



Mr. Dyson has volunteered his time to WLCL for the past 16+ years. It is time for several of our lake owners who are concerned with the lake conditions to shadow Mr. Dyson as he obtains lake permits, monitors the lake conditions, responds to weed complaints and learn the basics of lake environment.
